Class Descriptions & Policies

<p>Wine, Cheese, & Crafters: Come enjoy a wine tasting, cheese, crackers and other refreshments. While you are sipping wine and relaxing you can be working on your most recent craft project. Supplies to bring: Any materials you would need for your project. All of the studio tools are of course available for your use as well. \$10 pp, 2 hr. event</p>
<p>Crop Day: Enjoy 8-12 hours of nothing but cropping, talking, laughing, prizes and of course CHOCOLATE!! Complimentary coffee, tea, and water; dinner included. Supplies to bring: Any materials you would need for your scrapbook project. All of the studio tools are of course available for your use as well. \$15 pp, 8-12 hr. event</p>
<p>Cricut 101: Have a Cricut and not sure how to use it? Thinking about purchasing one and want to try it out first? In this class, we provide beginners with instructions and techniques to make the most of your Cricut. Supplies to bring (optional): Cricut machine, cartridges and paper. \$5 pp, 1 hr. class</p>
<p>Teabag Folding Card Class: Learn the beautiful paper craft art of teabag folding and create unique cards using this technique. Supplies to bring: Scissors, paper glue, paper cutter (optional). \$18 pp, 2 hr. class</p>
<p>Postcard Pizazz: In this class, you will learn to make handmade, mixed media postcards using a variety of materials including paint, paper and embellishments. You will explore the idea of building layers using different techniques to create these adorable cards! Supplies to bring: Scissors, paper mod podge, pictures if desired. \$18 pp, 2 hr. class</p>
<p>Iris Paper Folding Beginner Class: Learn the unique art of iris paper folding. In iris folding, strips of paper are layered over each other to create a pattern that resembles the iris of a camera. It's easy to do and the results are magnificent! Supplies to bring: Bone folder, Scissors, double sided tape, permanent adhesive runner. \$18 pp, 2 hr. class</p>
<p>A Muse Easy Breezy Card Class : If you love A Muse stamps as much as we do, you'll love this card class (taught by Liz Ballard, a Certified Instructor with A Muse Artstamps). You will make five adorable, warm weather-themed cards that are sure to delight those who receive them. We'll be using A Muse images, papers, and ribbon, as well as Copic markers, glitter, Stickles, and a variety of craft punches. Supplies to bring: Scissors, permanent adhesive runner. \$25 pp, 2 hr. class</p>
<p>Art Journaling: Art journaling is a way to play with materials of all kinds, explore an idea and express your creativity without worrying about a "perfect" end product. We will provide a theme to explore for the evening and a fellow art journaler, Marisa Tamao, to guide you along. Supplies to bring: Any materials you would like to use such as a journal, pen/markers, stamps (we have some in the studio for use), ink, oil pastels, and pictures if desired. \$15 pp, 2.5 hr. class</p>
<p>Introduction to Scrapbooking: Learn how to preserve your memories - creatively! This comprehensive class will provide a good overview to get you started. Class is structured to cover the following topics while creating a 2-page spread: 1) Photo Safe Materials (papers, pens, embellishments and adhesives.) 2) Cropping & Matting Photos 3) Tool Types 4) Page Composition 5) Basic Techniques (stamping, distressing, dry & heat embossing) All materials are included to create a 2-page spread. You may opt to bring 12-14 special photos to use in your spread. \$30 pp, 2.5 hr, class</p>
<p>Paper Quilling: In this class you will get an introduction to quilling (paper filigree). Quilling is the art of taking thin strips of colorful paper and rolling, pinning and gluing it into beautiful shapes. Supplies to bring: Scissors, white paper glue. \$18 pp, 2 hr. class</p>
<p>Mosaic Serving Tray: In this class you will learn how to turn paper into glass! Well, at least it will look that way. You'll create a gorgeous mosaic serving tray using paper, Glossy Accents, and some special techniques. Supplies to bring: Mod Podge, Glossy Accents, small paint brush. \$20 pp, 2.5 hr. class</p>
<p>Introduction to Mosaic Scrapbooking: Learn how to apply the mosaic technique of Tami Potter, Wish in the Wind to your scrapbook! This beginner's class will provide a good overview to get you started. All materials are included to create a 2-page spread. Also includes a cutting mat and template. Supplies to bring: Scissors, REMOVABLE DOTTO Adhesive, permanent adhesive of your choice, cork backed ruler, sharp craft knife. \$40 pp, 2.5 hr, class**</p>
