

## A la Carte Classes

### Art Journaling

Art Journaling is a way to play with materials of all kinds, explore an idea and express your creativity without worrying about a "perfect" end product. Our cozy studio is just the place to keep the "inner critic" away while you play. We will provide a theme to explore for the evening and an instructor to guide you along. **Supplies to bring:** Any materials you would like to use (a journal, paint, paper, rubber stamps, ink, chalk, photos, found objects, magazines, ribbon, buttons, embellishments of all kinds). All of the studio tools are of course available for your use as well. **\$12 pp, 2.5 hr. class**

### Introduction to Book Binding

Come and learn the basics of bookbinding as you create a small address book and a covered notebook using basic binding supplies. You will learn the secrets of making perfectly mitered corners, cutting book board, gluing paper to board, and even making a hinged cover. We'll also send you home with instructions for making a coordinating date book. **Supplies to bring:** sharp craft knife or box cutter with spare blades, non-skid ruler, glue stick or adhesive runner and a pencil. **\$38 pp, 2.5 hr. class**

### Introduction to Scrapbooking

Learn how to preserve your memories - creatively! This comprehensive class will provide a good overview to get you started. Class is structured to cover the following topics while creating a 2-page spread: 1) Photo Safe Materials (papers, pens, embellishments and adhesives.) 2) Cropping & Matting Photos 3) Tool Types 4) Page Composition 5) Basic Techniques (stamping, distressing, dry & heat embossing) **All materials are included to create a 2-page spread. You may opt to bring 12-14 special photos to use in your spread. \$35 pp, 2.5 hr, class**

### Decorative Lampshades

These easy-to-create lampshades can be decorated to match any décor, theme or mood you like. From the master crafter to the beginner looking for a fun time, anyone can sign up for this easy-to-follow class. **Supplies to bring:** Scissors, Mod Podge/glue glaze, beaded trim/fancy yarns (approx. 1 yard), any special photos, magazine cut-outs, quotes or other items to include in your design. **\$30 pp, 2 hr. class**

### Paper Quilling

In this class you will get an introduction to quilling (paper filigree). Quilling is the art of taking thin strips of colorful paper and rolling, pinning and gluing it into beautiful shapes. **Supplies to bring:** Scissors, white paper glue. **\$18 pp, 2 hr. class**

### Card Making

In this class you will learn several techniques to dress up and personalize a collection of greeting cards. Care enough to make them yourself! These cards will be displayed long after they're given, and add that personalized touch that any card should have. **Supplies to bring:** Scissors, paper glue, permanent adhesive runner. **\$18 pp, 2 hr. class**

### Collage Jewelry

In this class you will learn to create mini masterpieces. You'll apply collage techniques while creating a couple of wearable pins using materials such as decorative papers, charms, stamps, feathers, photos, and other found objects. **Supplies to bring:** Mod Podge/Decoupage Medium, scissors and any small photos or charms you would like to include. **\$18 pp, 2 hr. class**

### Mosaic Serving Tray

In this class you will learn how to turn paper into glass! Well, at least it will look that way. You'll create a gorgeous mosaic serving tray using paper, Glossy Accents, and some special techniques. **Supplies to bring:** Mod Podge, Glossy Accents, small paint brush. **\$20 pp, 2.5 hr. class**

### Intro to Collage

A collage is defined as an artistic composition using a variety of materials glued onto a surface, with lines and colors supplied by the artist. What is great about collage as an art medium is that anyone can achieve an interesting and expressive piece of artwork regardless of your skills with drawing or painting. It is all about play with images, textures, color and especially your imagination. **Bring along some images you find inspiring (ie: faces or figures cut from magazines), copies of photos (vintage, recent, black and white or color), scraps of paper you love the color or texture of, ephemera (life's leftovers ie: ticket stubs, game pieces) or embellishments you have hanging around as well as your favorite rubber stamps and your favorite inks. We will provide a lot of other materials as well as tips for creating great backgrounds using acrylics paints and all the inspiration needed to jumpstart your collage imagination. \$22 pp, 3 hr. class**
